Mandatory Retirement Legislation For Firefighters Referred to Committee

On May 11, 2011, [Bill 181, the *Fire Protection and Prevention Amendment Act, 2011*](#), was ordered referred to the Standing Committee on General Government.

[As previously reported](#), Bill 181 would, if passed, amend the *Fire Protection and Prevention Act, 1997* to provide for the mandatory retirement at age 60 of firefighters regularly assigned to fire suppression duties, in certain circumstances, and impose a duty of fair representation on bargaining agents in respect of firefighters in the unit, whether or not they are members of the bargaining agent.
