Ontario Minimum Wage to Increase on October 1, 2017

Date: September 20, 2017

On October 1, 2017, the general minimum wage in Ontario will increase from \$11.40 to \$11.60 an hour. This minimum wage applies to most employees.

Minimum wage rates for specified students, liquor servers, hunting and fishing guides and homeworkers will <u>increase on the same date</u>.

Note that the Ontario government has tabled legislation to increase the general minimum wage on January 1, 2018 to \$14.00 an hour, and on January 1, 2019 to \$15.00 an hour.
